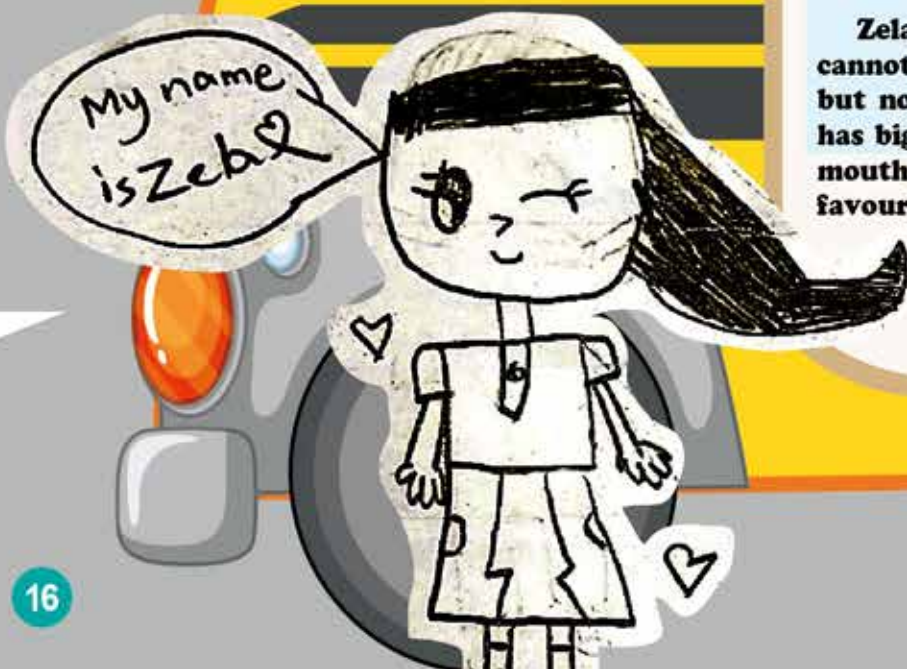

第三，也是大眾最擔心的問題。雖然網上資訊包羅萬有，但是有些資訊十分吸引，以致學生們都難以抗拒，在網課時只願觀看這些資訊，不能專心上課，養成不良的上課習慣，甚至墮入網絡陷阱。根據婦女事務委員會引述警方調查指出，疫情期間經網上交友解悶及裸聊勒索的事件明顯上升。去年首六個月已錄得206宗，較前年全年的171宗多了35宗。可見網課危機四伏，情況令人擔心。

總括來說，網上教學不但壞處多不勝數。一方面會減弱說話表達能力，又加重了基層家庭的負擔，一些警覺性不高的學生更可能會墮入網絡陷阱。因此我強烈反對網上教學，我希望全港小學未來能夠盡快恢復面授課，讓學童不再受到影響！
